ACTS 16:31

³¹ And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

***** The study of Salvation is called Soteriology.. The Doctrine of Salvation**

1. WHAT IS MEANT BY SALVATION / SAVE IN THE NEW TESTAMENT?

◆ Comes by Grace through faith in Jesus Christ

- John 1:12
- Ephesians 2:8-9

◆ GREEK WORD FOR SALVATION

SOTERIA (NOUN) S# GK4991 to deliver or to save

- Luke 1:71
- Acts 16:17
- Hebrews 5:9

SOTERION (ADJECTIVE) S# GK4992

- Luke 2:30
- Acts 28:28

◆ GREEK WORD FOR SAVE/SAVED

SOZO S# GK4982

- Matthew 10:22
- Luke 8:12
- 1 Timothy 2:4

◆ SOZO DEFINED

- 1. "to save, i.e. deliver or protect
{literally or figuratively}
properly, *deliver* out of danger and *into safety*; used principally of God *rescuing* believers *from* the penalty and power of sin – *and into His provisions (safety)*. Deliverance, rescue from sin and the consequences of sin
- 2. heal, be made whole
- 3. Restoration of a broken relationship between a Holy God and a sinful people

◆ **THREE BASIC MEANINGS**

◆ **FORGIVEN**

▪ **Romans 5:9**

9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

◆ **HEALED PHYSICALLY**

▪ **Matthew 9:21-22**

21 For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.

22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

◆ **DELIVERED FROM DANGER**

▪ **Acts 27: 20, 31**

20 And when neither sun nor stars in many days appeared, and no small tempest lay on us, all hope that we should be saved was then taken away.

31 Paul said to the centurion and to the soldiers, Except these abide in the ship, ye cannot be saved.

◆ **SOZO” challenges us to view salvation as not only a future hope but as an ongoing journey of becoming whole in Christ. Both physical and spiritual**

- ◆ **The THREE TENSES OF SALVATION**-- Has the sense of past, present, and future. Saved, being saved, and will be saved. Yesterday, today and tomorrow (forever).



CONSIDER ISAIAH 12

- 1 And in that day thou shalt say, O LORD, I will praise thee: though thou wast angry with me, thine anger is turned away, and thou comfortedst me.
- 2 Behold, God *is* my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH *is* my strength and *my* song; he also *is* become my salvation.
- 3 Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation.
- 4 And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted.
- 5 Sing unto the LORD; for he hath done excellent things: this *is* known in all the earth.
- 6 Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: for great *is* the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee.

2. WHAT IS MEANT BY SALVATION IN THE OLD TESTAMENT?

- ◆ Since Jesus is the WAY to Salvation in John 14:6, then what THE WAY before Jesus?
- ◆ The Path of Righteousness. Follow the Way of Jesus. He is the Pathway.
 - Psalms 25:4-5
4 Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.
5 Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou *art* the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.
 - Acts 4:12
12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
- ◆ The Law of the OT could not save. The purpose of the Law in the OT served as a tutor, schoolmaster or guardian. S# GK 3807.
 - Galatians 3:24
24 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
 - Galatians 3:11 tells us whereby Paul is quoting Habakkuk 2:4.
 - 11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.
 - Habakkuk 2:4
4 Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.
- ◆ So, if the LAW could not save how were people of the OT saved? Salvation was received in the OT by faith. Abraham lived hundreds of years before the law was given! So it was by faith that he was saved.
 - Genesis 15:6
6 And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.
 - Romans 4:3
3 For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.
- ◆ Scripture shows that David also was saved by faith.
 - Romans 4: 6-8
6 Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works,
7 Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered.
8 Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.
 - Psalms 32:1-2
1 A Psalm of David, Maschil. Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
2 Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.

In Romans 4:23-24 he writes, “The words ‘it was credited to him’ were written not for him alone, but also for us, to whom God will credit righteousness—for us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead.” In other words, righteousness is “credited” or given to those who have faith in God—Abraham, David, and we all share the same way of salvation.” <https://www.gotquestions.org/Old-Testament-salvation.html>

23 Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him;

24 But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;

◆ HEBREW WORD FOR SALVATION IN OLD TESTAMENT

YESHUAH S# H3444

- Means salvation, deliverance, victory, something saved

▪ Isaiah 12:2

2 Behold, God *is* my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH *is* my strength and *my* song; he also is become my salvation.

***GOD IS MY YESHUAH! YESHUAH IS THE HEBREW WORD FOR THE GREEK WORD JESUS!**

◆ HEBREW WORD FOR SAVE IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

YASHA S# H3467

- Means avenging, defend, deliverer, help, preserve, rescue, be safe,

▪ Exodus 2:17

17 And the shepherds came and drove them away: but Moses stood up and **helped** them, and watered their flock.

▪ Deuteronomy 22:27

27 For he found her in the field, *and* the betrothed damsel cried, and *there was* none to save her.

▪ Deuteronomy 33: 29

29 Happy *art* thou, O Israel: who *is* like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who *is* the sword of thy excellency! and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.

◆ CRUCIAL ELEMENTS FOR SALVATION

- THE BASIS for salvation is GRACE
- The INSTRUMENT of salvation is FAITH
- THE RESULT of salvation is GOOD WORKS
- THE CONFIDENCE of salvation is “WHAT GOD STARTED HE WILL FINISH”

3. WHAT IS SIN?

◆ WORDS TO DESCRIBE SIN IN BIBLE

▪ OLD TESTAMENT

- 6 nouns and 3 verbs to describe sin
- S# H2403 Chatta'ah- an offense, sin, sinner, sin offering, punishment of sin

▪ NEW TESTAMENT

- 33 words for sin or the acts of sin
- S# GK 266- Hamartia—to miss the mark- not hitting the target

◆ A CONDITION OF THE HEART THAT SEPARATES US FROM GOD

◆ TRANSGRESSION OF THE LAW OF GOD

▪ 1 John 3:4

4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

◆ REBELLION AGAINST GOD

▪ Deuteronomy 9:7

7 Remember, *and* forget not, how thou provokedst the LORD thy God to wrath in the wilderness: from the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD.

- Sin is not just bad behavior, it is rebellion against God's authority. It separates us from him.

4. TYPES OF SIN

◆ ORIGINAL SIN - ADAMIC NATURE- THE FLESH- SIN NATURE- INHERITED SIN

- Adam and Eve - ate the fruit from the TREE OF KNOWLEDGE AND GOOD AND EVIL

o Genesis 3

- Inner nature was transformed – our sinful nature enslaves us to sin. The sinful tendencies, desires, and dispositions in our hearts with which we are all born.

- We all enter the world with a fallen nature therefore sin is inherit in us We naturally love sin

o Psalms 51:5 –

5 Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me

o Ephesians 2:3 –

3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

◆ IMPUTED SIN

- Charged legally to our account, accredited to

- Impute means ascribed to or assign responsibility to. It means that someone is responsible for something that has happened

- Adam's guilt has been assigned to humanity and we deserve the same punishment.

▪ 1 Corinthians 15:22

22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

▪ Romans 5:12-21

12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

13 For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law.

5. PENALTY OF SIN

◆ DEATH- SEPARATION FROM GOD

- ROMANS 3:23

23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

- ROMANS 6:23

23 For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

- o SPIRITUAL DEATH -- we are not exempt from the natural consequences of a broken relationship with the Father.
- o PHYSICAL DEATH – Brought into world through Adam’s transgression
- o ULTIMATELY ETERNAL SEPARATION (TO BE SAVED IS TO BE RESUED FROM THE ULTIMATE SPIRITUAL DEATH AND BROUGHT INTO ULTIMATE SPIRITUAL LIFE!

◆ CURSES

- Deuteronomy 28—BLESSING AND CURSES

- GALATIANS 3:10

- o 10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.
- o Reinforces the idea that the law reveals the standard of righteousness and the penalty for failing to meet it.

6. CONCEPTS OF SALVATION

◆ REDEMPTION

- Specifically meant to purchase a slave’s freedom. God purchased our freedom and we are no longer in bondage. He paid the RANSOM for us.
 - o 1 Corinthians 6:20
20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
 - o Colossians 1:14
 - o Matthew 20:28
 - o 1 Timothy 2:6
- Meaning to buy out or to buy back... The result of ATONEMENT (AT ONE MENT). (S# H3722).
 - o No Greek word for cover or atonement in NT but the Greek word (S# G2433) hilaskomai means to make reconciliation to oneself, to atone for sin, propitiation.
 - Hebrews 2:17
 - Hebrews 9:22 shed blood
 - o ATONEMENT (Gen. 6:14 Pitch, cover) refers to the act of covering one’s sins, making amends for wrongdoing, such as through sacrifice but redemption is the result of the atonement
- Example in Bible: Kinsman redeemer- Hebrew S# H1350 Go’el- Boaz in the Book of Ruth 4:1-4:9

◆ JUSTIFICATION

- The act of God declaring a sinner righteous from guilt
- The act of providing valid reasons, evidence
- “Just as if” I had never sinned
 - o Romans 5:1-2
1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

o Romans 3:28

28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.

◆ **SANCTIFICATION**

- The process of being “set apart” for God’s purpose and transformed in the likeness of God
- The act of being made Holy
 - o John 17:16-17
16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
 - o Hebrews 10:10
10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once *for all*.
 - o Hebrews 10:14
14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
 - o 1 Corinthians 6:11
11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.
 - o 2 Corinthians 3:18
 - o 1 Thessalonians 4:3
 - o 1 Peter 1: 15-16

◆ **GLORIFICATION**

- The final step of salvation—the final removal of sin from the life of a believer. The completion of God’s work in the believer.
- Perfected in body and soul- freed from sin and united with God
- 1 Corinthians 15: 51-53
51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.
- Two meanings
 - o An act of Praise Honoring God through worship
 - o A future final state of believers when we receive our perfect resurrected bodies
 - Titus 2:13
13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;
 - Philippians 3:20-21
20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:
21 Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.
 - Romans 8:18
18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time *are not worthy to be compared with* the glory which shall be revealed in us.

7. SYMBOLS OF SALVATION USED IN THE BIBLE

◆ ARK

- Represents salvation from judgment; a refuge
- A type of Christ- It sheltered Noah and his family from destruction
- Hebrews 11:7

7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

- 1 Peter 3:20

20 Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water.

- LESSONS FROM NOAH'S ARK (unknown)

1. Always live a righteous life- even if you are the only one; it will be noticed
2. Listen to what God tells you- your life depends on it.
3. Plan ahead. It wasn't raining when Noah built the ark.
4. Put action to your faith. Noah could have believed in God, yet still drowned if he hadn't built the ark.
5. Stay fit. When you're 600 years old, someone might ask you to do something really big.
6. Don't listen to critics. Just get on with what has to be done.
7. Build your future on high ground.
8. Finish what you start.
9. Two heads are better than one.
10. Don't miss the boat.
11. Don't forget that we're all in the same boat.
12. Speed isn't always an advantage. The snails were on board with the cheetahs.
13. When you are stressed, float a while.
14. Remember that the ark was built by amateurs while the Titanic was built by professionals.
15. Remember that woodpeckers INSIDE are a larger threat than the storm outside.
16. Have patience! The ark wasn't built in a year. The flood wasn't finished in 40 days and 40 nights.
17. And remember, no matter what the storm, when you are one with God there is a rainbow waiting.

◆ BLOOD OF THE LAMB

- Passover Lamb was a sign of deliverance and protection
- Exodus 12:13

13 And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye *are*: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy *you*, when I smite the land of Egypt.

- John 1:29

29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

- Hebrews 9:14

14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

◆ LIGHT

- Represents TRUTH

- Psalms 27:1

1 A Psalm of David. The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

- Proverbs 6:23

23 For the commandment *is* a lamp; and the law *is* light; and reproofs of instruction *are* the way of life:

- Acts 26:23

23 That Christ should suffer, *and* that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles.

◆ BREAD/WINE

- Symbolizes the body and blood of Jesus given for the salvation of believers

- Nourishment, covenant, communion with God

- Luke 22:19-20

19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

20 Likewise He also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup *is* the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.

- Matthew 26:27-28

27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;

28 For this is my blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

◆ ROCK

- Represents God's character, refuge, foreshadows Christ

- Isaiah 28:16

16 That Christ should suffer, *and* that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles.

- 1 Corinthians 10:4

4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

◆ CROSS

- Represents the crucifixion of Jesus Christ

- Victory over sin and death

- The sacrificial love of Jesus for humanity

- 1 Corinthians 1:18

18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

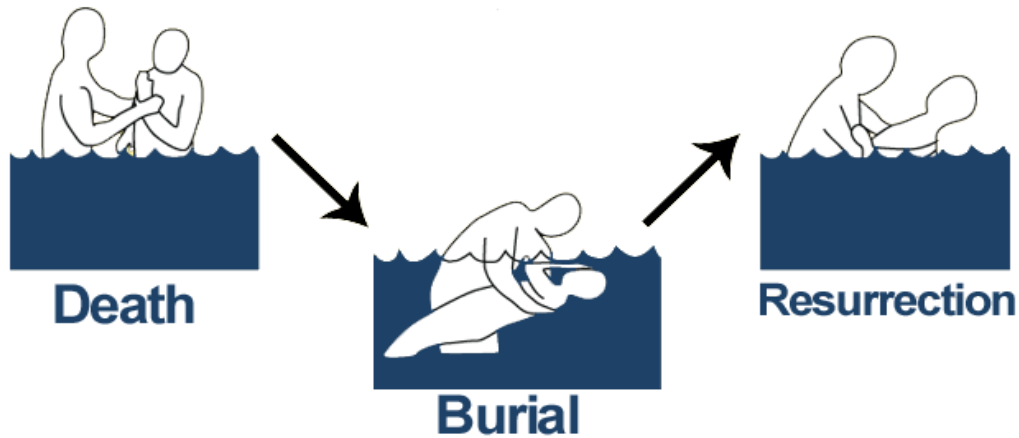
◆ WATER BAPTISM- TO SUBMERGE

- Believers' union with Jesus in His Death, Burial and Resurrection

- o Believer's death- going into the water

- o Believers Burial- going under the water

- o Believer's resurrection – Coming up out of the water



▪ **Acts 2:38**

38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

▪ **Romans 6:3-4**

3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?

4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

▪ **Galatians 3:27**

27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

9. THE PLAN OF SALVATION

Romans 3:23

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Romans 10:9

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

Romans 6;23

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of god is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 10:13

For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

WE ARE SAVED THROUGH THE GRACE (FAVOR) OF GOD NOT BY ANY GOOD WORKS WE DO

Ephesians 2:8 - 9

**For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
Not of works, lest any man should boast**

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

THERE IS ONLY ONE WAY TO HEAVEN

John 14:6

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

1. Admit you are a sinner.

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;" (Romans 3:23)

"Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:" (Romans 5:12)

"If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us." (1 John 1:10)

2. Be willing to turn from sin (repent).

Jesus said: "I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." (Luke 13:5)

"And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:" (Acts 17:30)

3. Believe that Jesus Christ died for you, was buried, and rose from the dead.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

"But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners. Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." (Romans 10:9)

4. Through prayer, invite Jesus into your life to become your personal Saviour.

"For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." (Romans 10:10)

"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." (Romans 10:13)

What to pray: Dear God, I am a sinner and need forgiveness. I believe that Jesus Christ shed His precious blood and died for my sin. I am willing to turn from sin. I now invite Christ to come into my heart and life as my personal Saviour.

"But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:" (John 1:12)

"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new." (2 Corinthians 5:17)

If you have received Jesus Christ as your Saviour, as a Christian you should:

1. Read your Bible every day to get to know Christ better.

"Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15)

"Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." (Psalms 119:105)

2. Talk to God in prayer every day.

"And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive." (Matthew 21:22)

"Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God." (Philippians 4:6)

3. Be baptized, worship, fellowship, and serve with other Christians in a church where Christ is preached and the Bible is the final authority.

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:" (Matthew 28:19)

"Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching." (Hebrews 10:25)

"All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:" (2 Timothy 3:16)

4. Tell others about Christ.

"And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15)

"For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!" (1 Corinthians 9:16)

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek." (Romans 1:16)

BIBLE STUDY THREE/FOUR

JESUS IS GOD

1 Timothy 3:16

16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

There is only one true, supreme, GOD. The God of Abraham, Issac and Jacob. The God of the Holy Bible.

We believe in the Trinity of the three persons in one Godhead, not three Gods but rather one God with three distinct persons. A concept that only God can fully explain but He has revealed Himself to us through each, God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

God does not have a natural son. When we speak of God the Son or the Son of God we are referring to His divinity. The leaders of the people, kings, princes, judges, as holding authority from God, were called sons of God. It is a term used Daniel 3:25. It is a title expressing His divinity and authority.

The fact that Jesus (Yeshua or Joshua) is Yahweh (Lord) can be proved by comparing OT verses with the corresponding NT verses.

- ◆ Isaiah 40:3 speaks about preparing the way for the LORD (Yahweh). When we compare this verse with Mark 1:3 we readily see that Jesus is the LORD who had the way prepared for him by John the Baptist.
- ◆ In Joel 2:32a it says that whoever calls upon the Name of the LORD (Yahweh) will be saved. This verse is quoted by Peter in Acts 2:21, and by Paul in Romans 10:13. Both apostles are clearly referring to Jesus as the LORD.
- ◆ In Isaiah 6:1-10 we read about the marvelous vision that Isaiah had revealing the glory of the LORD (Yahweh). John tells us, in John 12:40-41, that this vision revealed the glory of Jesus.
- ◆ In Isaiah 44:6, Yahweh refers to himself as “the First and the Last”. In Revelation 1:8 and 17, Jesus similarly refers to himself as “the Alpha and the Omega” and “the First and the Last”.
- ◆ In Zechariah 12:10 the LORD (Yahweh) is speaking and says that, “they will look on Me whom they have pierced.” [This is obviously Jesus speaking (Psalms 22:16; John 19:34). This passage from Zechariah appears again in Revelation 1:7b and is clearly about Jesus Christ.
