Essentials ☐ Water – 1 gallon per person per day (3-day supply) ☐ Food – non-perishable, easy-to-prepare meals (granola bars, canned food) ☐ Multi-tool (knife, pliers, screwdriver, scissors, etc) ☐ Flashlight – With extra batteries or hand - crank radio, manual can opener ☐ Lighter or waterproof matches ☐ Bags (trash, storage, or emergency ponchos) ☐ Firestarter, Duct tape, Zip ties ☐ Cash (small bills & coins)	Toiletries ☐ Toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss ☐ Hand or bar soap, rubbing alcohol, hand sanitizer ☐ Masks (N95 recommended) ☐ Feminine hygiene products ☐ Gloves
